PARADE PARTICIPANT EVENT INFORMATION:

Early Auto Gates: Auto Gates A, C, D, and E are available to enter at 10:10 AM

Early Stadium Gates: Right and Left Centerfield and Right Plaza Gates are available to enter at 10:10 AM

***Parade Start:** 11:00 AM

Parade End: 11:40 AM

** Parade is limited to Coaches and Players in team issued uniforms. All other family members may watch from the Pavilions.*

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- **REQUIRED: To participate in the parade, Players and Coaches must wear their team issued uniforms or jerseys to participate in parade.**
- **Tickets:** To enter the stadium each guest is required to have an admission ticket to the game. All tickets are digital and can be accessed through the MLB Ballpark App or www.dodgers.com/mytickets. Screenshots of tickets are not considered valid tickets and will not scan at the gates. You must present a valid mobile ticket (and not a screenshot) to be permitted entry into the stadium.
- **Parking Passes:** We recommend you purchase parking in advance. Prepaid parking is available until 3 hours before the scheduled first pitch. To purchase parking, view freeway routes, and parking maps please visit, www.dodgers.com/parking.
- **Clear bag policy:** Bags, backpacks, beach bags, hard/soft coolers, large purses, etc. are no longer permitted. Only adult diaper bags, diaper bags that accompany infants, clear plastic bags smaller than 12" x 12" x 6", and non-clear wristlets/clutches no larger than 5" x 8" x 2" are permitted and subject to search.
- **Signs:** Dodger Stadium does not allow banners of any kind.
- **Prohibited Items Not Allowed in Dodger Stadium:** Items not permitted into the stadium include, but not limited to, the following: umbrellas, glass bottles, metal cans, noise-making devices such as horns, air horns, cowbells, whistles, beach balls or other inflatables. Please review all stadium guidelines at www.dodgers.com/information.
- **No re-entry policy:** Dodger Stadium has a no re-entry policy at our gates. Please ensure that you have all personal belongings as you will not be able to go back and forth between the parking lot and stadium.
- Please be advised that all bags and persons are subject to search. Video and audio surveillance in use on these premises. By entering these premises, you agree that you are subject to the Los Angeles Dodgers Ticket Terms and Conditions of Admission

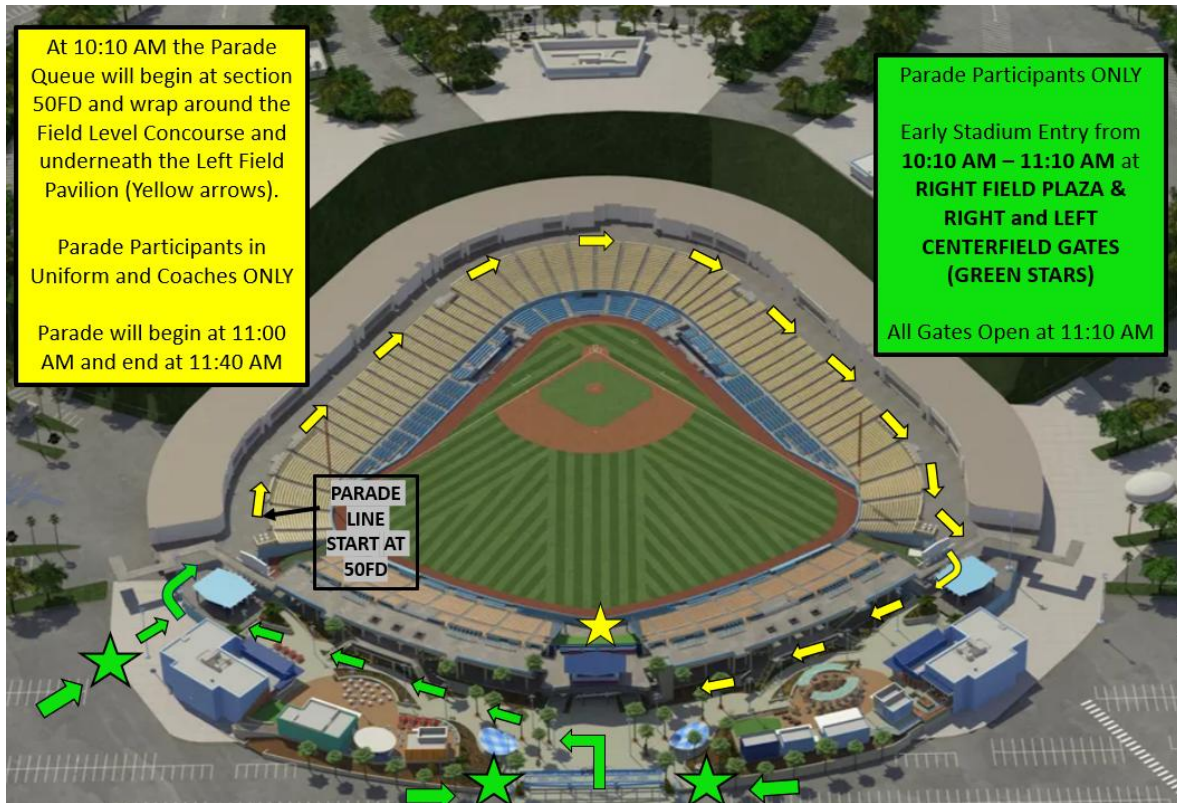

STADIUM ENTRY INFORMATION:

- Starting at **10:10 AM**, Youth Baseball Softball Participants may use the Right Centerfield and Right Plaza entrance.
- It is encouraged to parade with your team to parade. **Please coordinate a pregame meeting spot outside of the stadium gates and enter the stadium together.**
- For the safety of all fans, please do not congregate in/or block walkways.



PARADE INFORMATION:

- The parade queue will begin at section 50 Field and travel along the field level concourse and underneath the LEFT FIELD PAVILION. The parade path will travel through Centerfield and along the Warning Track.
- **The Parade is estimated to begin at 11:00 AM and end at 11:40 AM.**
- There is a limited time to activate the parade before the game begins. To ensure that the kids get the full experience **PLEASE LIMIT ACCESS TO THE PARADE TO PLAYERS AND COACHES IN TEAM ISSUED UNIFORM ONLY.**
- **It is not guaranteed that your group or player will be able to participate in the event.**
- As the stadium gates are opening early to accommodate Parade Participants, please note that fans may only access the Centerfield Plaza areas until the remainder of the ballpark opens at 11:10 AM.
- Food and beverage, selfie sticks, gloves, balls and bats are prohibited on the field.
- Parents and siblings are welcome to watch the parade from the Pavilions.
- **PLEASE REFRAIN FROM STEPPING ON THE GRASS AND/OR STOPPING IN THE PARADE PATH.**
- Please follow instructions from all Dodgers Staff and Personnel.
